Florists and Decorations

- 1. All decorations should be in place prior to any pre-service photographs (if applicable).
- 2. Webster Gardens does not provide candelabras but does have a Unity Candle stand for use in our Sanctuary.
- 3. Webster Gardens does not provide or encourage use of a runner for the center aisle as it may be a tripping hazard. If you choose to use a runner, you will need to obtain it from your florist. The church aisle is 48½ feet long. If an aisle runner is used, it must be pinned at the FRONT of the Sanctuary (at the step) so it does not move. Flower petals are allowed inside the church, as long as they are thrown on the runner.
- 4. Each section of the Sanctuary has 13 rows of pews. Nothing may be taped, nailed or glued to the pews or any other furniture.
- 5. The throwing of rice, confetti, bird seed, etc is not permitted in the church or anywhere on church grounds. If you wish to be showered with something as you leave we suggest bubbles outside the building.
- 6. Please remember the sanctuary is the place of worship for this congregation. Again, we ask that no food or drink be brought into the church sanctuary. No church "furniture" may be moved around in the sanctuary, nor may any items the church has placed on the altar be moved or removed. Flowers only may be placed on the flower stands in the chancel. Paraments, altar cloths, are not decorations and may not be obscured or changed to coordinate with your wedding as the colors reflect the season of the church year.
- 7. Once a florist is selected, arrange delivery times according to when you scheduled the Wedding Coordinator to be at Webster Gardens. Someone needs to be at the church to accept the delivery; be sure to discuss this with the Wedding Coordinator.
- 8. All decorations must be discussed with the Wedding Coordinator prior to rehearsal.
